

## Public Sector Apprenticeship Target Report 2020

### Introduction

Public sector bodies with more than 250 staff members have a target set by the Government to employ an average of at least 2.3% of their staff as new Apprentice starts each year. Bodies must have regard to this target when making workforce planning decisions and as part of this regard must publish Apprenticeship data.

This report covers the reporting period of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020.
